

Operating and maintenance instructions

BLÜCHER® WaterLine - stainless steel shower channels



Comprising:

Shower channels BLÜCHER® WaterLine for concrete, tiled and vinyl floors with liquid or sheet membrane or without membrane and for installation along 1 - 3 walls or free in the floor. A range of gratings is available for the BLÜCHER® WaterLine shower channels.

Accessories and spare parts:

Water trap 510

For the owner/user:

BLÜCHER® WaterLine shower channel in stainless steel AISI 304 has been installed.

Prior to starting use:

- Check that the channel has been cleaned leaving no concrete spills etc.
- Check that a water trap has been installed.

Normal operation:

In case of many impurities it may be necessary to clean the water trap at appropriate intervals.

Cleaning:

- Remove the grating.
- Clean channel, trap and grating as necessary.
- Install the grating.

Cleaning of drains with colour-coated surface:

The coloured BLÜCHER drainage products have been PVD coated to add elegant colours to the stainless steel surface.

Cleaning requirements for these coloured products are in principle the same as for the naturally coloured stainless steel products – discolouring can, however, occur if detergents containing bleach (chloride or hydrogen peroxide) or strong acid/caustic detergents are used.

The products are best cleaned by washing with mild soapy water on a soft cloth. Never use steel wool or sponge scouring pads.
